SUMMARY:

This talk will share some of the experiences of a nuclear engineer who not long ago was a student himself wondering about where in the cosmos he was headed. Life as a nuclear professional is like living in a glass house with people throwing stones at you. It is intensely rewarding and intensely controversial, and both aspects merge in the act of communicating nuclear s benefits to the public. Dr. Whitlock s involvement in this cause can be traced to pro-nuclear activism at the age of twelve, adding a unique perspective to his subsequent adventures dealing with anti-nuclear activists, students and other groups. His efforts in the public arena have earned him the Canadian Nuclear Society s 1999 Education and Communication Award. He still wonders about where in the cosmos he is headed.
